 - Identity Assurance Programme
 - A. Stimulating a market of Identity Services & procuring services from private sector through a hub
 - 1. Links from the hub of providers to Govt services
 - B. Users have choice of who to use as Identity Providers
 - C. Working with Govt Depts to understand needs
 - D. Provide access to federated system & depts don't need to manage user credentials or identity
 - E. Currently in Private Beta - moving to public Beta in Summer
 - 1. First test is HMRC, then DVLA
 - F. Could certainly work with Local PS

 - A. First Alpha - benefits of interoperability:
integrates local solution for simple authentication with GDS IDA Services for higher level assurance (approved by CESG)
 - B. Attributes Exchange
 - 1. Blue Badge business case

- III. ID Assurance procurement issues for LG - current framework only in place for CG - let's fix this!
 - A. Need to understand demand for this

 - A. Currently low level assurance
 - B. Approach for risk assessment to judge level of assurance required
 - 1. Standards exist on GDS website (Good Practice Guide 43)

- VI. How to passport Attribute Exchange between organisations?
 - A. Collector of certain attributes could possibly pass on to other key services, but better to build an accredited personal data store
